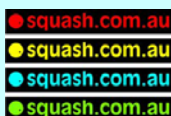

PENNANT REPORT

The VMSA implemented major changes to the pennant competition for the recently completed Spring season. An East and a West draw was created with PAR 15 scoring introduced and 7.30pm start times in all grades. One underage player is also permitted in a team to introduce new players to Masters subject to approval by the Pennant Director. There has also been free team entry to encourage clubs to enter more sides. These changes were felt as necessary to keep our struggling pennant alive as well as taking on board concerns raised about late nights and travel issues which seem to be big factors in the loss of teams from the competition. As a result, we had six grades with two in the West and four in the East.

The changes appear to be well received but the proof of a successful outcome cannot be measured just yet. We realise more time is required to see if people return to playing and grades increase as a result. The VMSA has done what it can to re-ignite interest in playing Masters but now it is up to you to encourage players new and old back to pennant.

Congratulations to the winners in the newly configured Spring Pennant and thanks to all clubs and players for participating. Autumn pennant in 2024 is set to commence in early February with clubs to be notified of the exact date.

BALLARAT PROMOTING SQUASH IN SCHOOLS

Ballarat Secondary Schools competition (BASS)

Since COVID the BASS competition has developed into a very vibrant competition. The competing schools are Ballarat Clarendon College, Grammar, St Pats, Loreto, Damascus and Mount Clear. Ballarat members such as the Landy Family and Marika Rawlings take responsibility for a school. They explain the rules, help with coaching and referee games.

Community Development

For the past three years, schools with programs for students who are "disengaged from the classroom" have been developed by BSRA. Phoenix, Yuille Park and Berry Street have participated in the program.

Primary Schools

Despite a lot of school visits, fifty-four primary schools in total 2 to 3 times, only two schools, Alfredton and Yuille Park have classes who attend BSRA. The Racquet Ball Rebels program, whereby you take the racquet and balls etc. to the schools was only taken up by Invermay Primary School, so this will be a priority going forward.

In summary, Ballarat is very fortunate to have a centre with 11 courts to cater for all class sizes.

There are many elite schools in close proximity to the centre so with over 3000 students at least coming into the centre through the Schools Program, the future looks very bright. Tara and John have done an amazing job in putting this together with help from others.

Terry is a Life Member of VMSA and has also received the Victorian and Australian Judith Goadby Memorial Award.

As Terry said at the recent AMSA AGM, "Squash is a sport that I love so much, and it has been a great ride."

Two players per team, player one 20 min, player two 20 min then doubles play 20 min total 1 hour play per round. Eye wear for doubles is a non negotiable must.
2. Tournament Entry Fees are \$50 for Non-members, \$40 for VMSA Financial Members and \$35 for VMSA Financial Members who have played 25+ tournaments. Early Bird Rate gives a discount of \$5 for online entries only, received 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the tournament.
3. All players must fulfil their obligations to other participants by competing in all matches set down for them.
4. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept, decline or re-grade any entries.

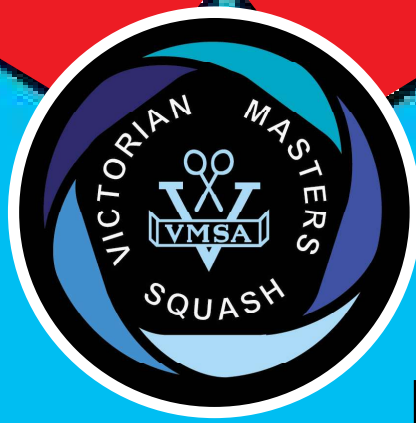

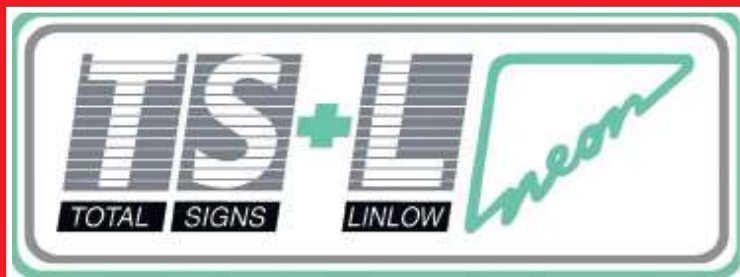
